As there were no applications, one of the Senior Neurologist members of the KNA had been requested to accept the nomination. She informed that KNA President Dr. Baligar would be announcing the name of President elect during

		6. She also informed that, as per the interim meeting held on 5 th March 2022, Dr. Harsha, local organizing secretary has been communicated regarding the necessary plans for conducting KNACON 2022 at Mysuru.
