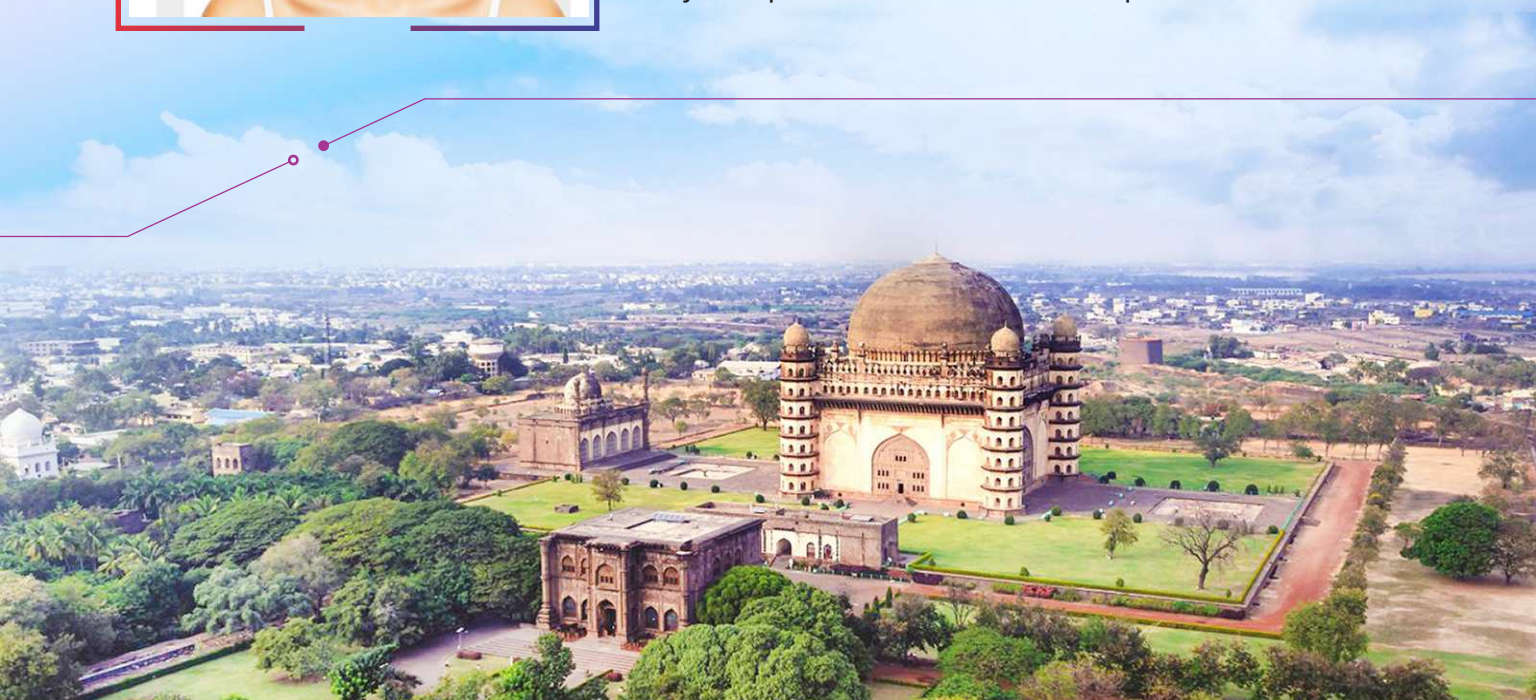
## (A FULL DAY EEG & BOTOX WORKSHOP)

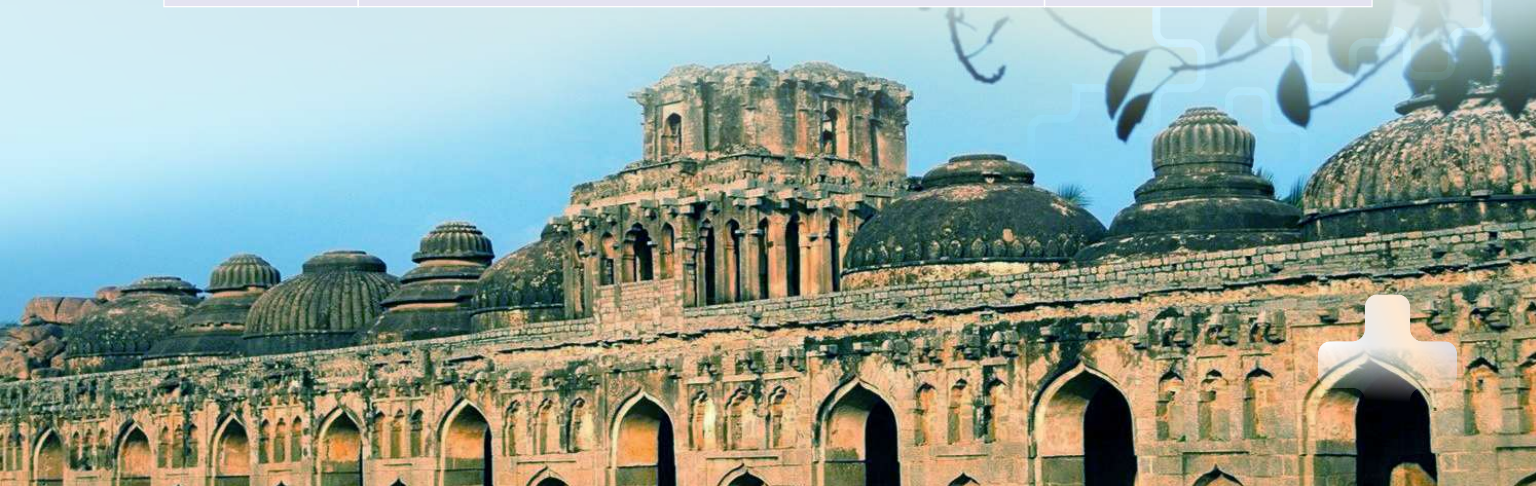

- **Font** : Times New Roman, Font Size 12
- **Word Limit** : 250 words (excluding title, author names, and institutions)
- **Title Limit** : Maximum 75 characters

### STRUCTURE OF THE ABSTRACT

- **Title** : Must be in CAPITAL LETTERS (scientific names in italics, upper & lower case)
- **Objectives** : Clearly state the main objective of the study
- **Materials & Methods** : Brief description of study design and methodology
- **Results** : Key findings with appropriate statistics
- **Conclusion** : Conclusions supported directly by results

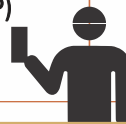

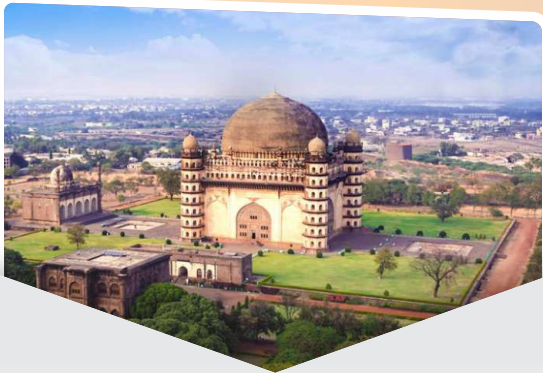

## GOL GUMBAZ 3 km

One of the largest domes in the world, Gol Gumbaz is the mausoleum of Mohammed Adil Shah. Its whispering gallery and massive architecture make it a global landmark of Deccan heritage.



## SHIVAGIRI TEMPLE 6 km

Shivagiri is famous for its towering 85-foot statue of Lord Shiva. Situated on a hilltop, it offers a peaceful spiritual experience and panoramic views of the city.



## IBRAHIM ROZA 4 km

Built across the Krishna River, Almatti Dam is a major hydroelectric and irrigation project. The vast reservoir and scenic surroundings make it an impressive engineering landmark.



**HAMPI** 160 km

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Hampi was once the capital of the Vijayanagara Empire. Its grand temples, royal ruins, and stone chariot attract visitors from across the world.
